

OFFICIAL CHECKLIST OF TRINIDAD & TOBAGO

The official list of species of Trinidad & Tobago stands at 498 as of 31st August 2024. This list is updated periodically to reflect additions brought about by the significant increase in coverage by both local and visiting birdwatchers to our islands.

This list comprises two components:

- (a) species adjudged as correctly identified by the Trinidad & Tobago Rare Birds Committee since September 1995 that occur naturally or have a sustainable breeding population in Trinidad & Tobago and
- (b) species adjudged acceptable by Richard French prior to the TTRBC's inauguration.

Names and order of species follows that of the American Ornithologists' Union (AOU) and their South American Checklist Committee (SACC), current as of December 2022
